for the duration of 3 years (PhD) resp. of 2 years (postdoc) on a fixed-term basis. Candidates for the research assistant positions must have completed a degree (Diploma or Master) in mathematics or a related subject. Candidates for the postdoctoral positions must hold a PhD in mathematics or a related subject.

We are committed to increase the proportion of women in research. Qualified female applicants are therefore particularly encouraged to apply. Among candidates of equal aptitude and qualifications, a person with disabilities will be given preference.
