Universität Hamburg invites applications for a Research Associate in accordance with Section 28 subsection 1 of the Hamburg higher education act (Hamburgisches Hochschulgesetz, HmbHG). The position commences on April 1, 2019.

It is remunerated at the salary level TV-L 13 and calls for 100% of standard work hours per week.*

The fixed-term nature of this contract is based upon Section 2 of the academic fixed-term labor contract act (Wissenschaftszeitvertragsgesetz, WissZeitVG). The initial fixed term is three years.

The University aims to increase the number of women in research and teaching and explicitly encourages women to apply. Equally qualified female applicants will receive preference in accordance with the Hamburg act on gender equality (Hamburgisches Gleichstellungsgesetz, HmbGleiG).

Responsibilities:

Associates will be expected primarily to teach and conduct research. The associate will also have the opportunity to pursue further academic qualifications, in particular a doctoral dissertation. At least one-third of set working hours will be made available for the associate's own academic work.

Specific Duties:

The task area includes supportive co-working in research, teaching and evaluation concerning all areas of business informatics. The teaching obligation comprises 4 LVS. The phd thesis is to be established in the broad topic area of "Digital Transformation" and can be written in German as well as in English. We are happy to also consider international applicants; nevertheless, it is of utmost importance that lectures and courses can be given in the German language.

Requirements:

A university degree in a relevant field. The studied degree as well as the doctorate should be completed within the fields of information systems, or a study field with focus on information systems (business administration, business mathematics, business engineering or mathematics). Excellent German and English skills are of utmost importance.

Severely disabled applicants will receive preference over equally qualified non-disabled applicants.
